Viewing Course Recommendations in PowerSchool for Incoming Freshmen Class

The following information is provided to support **current 8th grade students** and parents/ guardians as they begin to prepare for the transition to Bexley High School during the 2018-2019 academic year. Students and parents/guardians are strongly encouraged to review the course recommendations PRIOR to meeting with their high school counselor, as previous experience has shown this significantly improves the productivity of these meetings.

Viewing Your Course Recommendations in PowerSchool

1. Go to www.bexleyschools.org and scroll over the **Find It Fast** text on the top, left-hand side of the page. When you scroll over the **Find It Fast** text, a drop-down menu will appear. From this drop-down menu, select **Parent & Student Portal**. From the portal page, select **PowerSchool** under the **Students** menu in the center of the page.



2. Login to *PowerSchool* using the **student's** username and password. The username uses the format of FirstName.LastName and the password is unique to the individual student.
