Viewing Course Recommendations in PowerSchool for Incoming Freshmen Class

The following information is provided to support **current 8th grade students** and parents/ guardians as they begin to prepare for the transition to Bexley High School during the 2018-2019 academic year. Students and parents/guardians are strong encouraged to review the course recommendations PRIOR to meeting with their high school counselor, as previous experience has shown this significantly improves the productivity of these meetings.

Viewing Your Course Recommendations in PowerSchool

Go to <u>www.bexleyschools.org</u> and scroll over the Find It Fast text on the top, left-hand side of the page. When you scroll over the Find It Fast text, a drop-down menu will appear. From this drop-down menu, select Parent & Student Portal. From the portal page, select *PowerSchool* under the *Students* menu in the center of the page.



2. Login to *PowerSchool* using the <u>student's</u> username and password. The username uses the format of FirstName.LastName and the password is unique to the individual student.

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3. After logging in, students will be directed to the **Home Screen** (example shown below). From this screen, select the **Class Registration** link on the left-hand side.

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4. The **Class Registration** page provides detailed information for each <u>Core Subject Area</u> (English, Math, Science, Social Studies) as well as <u>Elective options</u> (year-long & semester-long).

NOTE: 8th grade students are NOT REQUIRED to enter his/her own course requests. The courses you are requesting will be entered / updated in PowerSchool when you meet with your assigned school counselor.



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Within each *Core Subject* & *Elective Type (year-long or semester long),* current 8th grade students can view individual course recommendations within each category as well as any year-long elective recommendations that have been entered (not required but the most common elective recommendations will reflect Band, Orchestra or Choir). Click on the \bigcirc icon to view the recommendation to see what courses are available and/or what your individual teacher has recommended as the most apprioprate course option within the subject area. An example of the screen you will see after selecting the icon is provided below.
