Semester 2 Calendar

On days marked “A”, students with last names A-La will attend in person while students with last names Le-Z will work asynchronously from home.

On days marked “B”, students with last names Le-Z will attend in person while students with last names A-La will work asynchronously from home.

There are no planned days where all students are at home learning on Zoom during this hybrid model. Zoom can be utilized for situations where students are required to quarantine (see more below) or if the building can not open due to inclement weather.

What about Middle School A/ B days?

Some of our classes meet on an every other day basis (6th grade writing and world language, band, choir, orchestra, study hall, etc.). We have called these “A Day, B Day” for years so the district move to use that terminology has been confusing. So that students are not consistently at home for the same classes, schedule will work like this:

A weekly calendar will be sent out each Sunday as part of our regular, weekly update and students will be able to see this information on their google calendar.

Locker Assignments

We will assign lockers after winter break to give students a place to store their coats and school supplies. Students will only be permitted to access their lockers at the beginning and end of day and at lunch time to minimize congestion in the hallway. Students will be assigned a locker near their period 1 classroom and they will be assigned in alternating fashion for A group/ B group students (so that lockers immediately next to each other are not accessed at the same time).

What happens if my student is required to quarantine?

Once the school is notified that your student is required to quarantine based on the district developed guidelines, a case manager will contact your student with information about how to stay engaged in their learning and access additional academic and mental health resources while in quarantine.

MS/HS: The case manager will share information that will include reminders about Canvas, email, as well as a link to a help desk. Students will be expected to view their classes through provided Zoom links (or prerecorded video lessons). While the classroom instruction is viewable through the Zoom link, this is not a complete replacement for live instruction. Students will not experience the same level of interaction that they do during in-person or dedicated Zoom days but they will have a window into the learning environment.

During the quarantine, a school counselor will reach out to your student within the first few days to provide an opportunity for emotional support, encouragement, and connection. School counselors remain available to all students and families as needed. Please do not hesitate to contact them.

Your student's teachers remain available via email, office hours, and/or study hall for additional remote academic assistance and guidance.

Bexley e-Learning Academy

All current e-learning families should complete the form to indicate their preference either way to remain in e-Learning or return to school. Families whose students are currently attending school on-site in the hybrid model should ONLY complete the form if they want to enroll in the Bexley e-Learning Academy for second semester.
