Students in grades K-12 may be referred for evaluation in any area during a fall and spring window. Assessments selected from approved list based on student needs.

Required Components Per Ohio Law and Rule:

- Use instruments from Ohio's approved list of assessments
- Allow for assessment and identification K-12
- Whole grade screening for superior cognitive ability, creative thinking, reading, and math once in K-2 and once in 3-6
- Two opportunities a year to be evaluated
- Use identification scores set in Ohio law
- A single test score = identification
- Once identified, always identified
- Identifications and scores transfer between Ohio schools
- Referred transfer students tested within 90 days

Questions to Consider:

- Are grades levels used for cognitive/creative thinking screening best options?
- How do we generate referrals for underrepresented populations?
- Is there value in expanded efforts for visual/performing arts identifications? If so, thoughts on approaches for generating referrals?
