Pride Pass

A [Pride Pass](#) can be purchased for any student for \$75 and gives them free admission to all middle and high school home athletic events (excluding OHSAA & MSL tournaments) as well as all theater department productions. Students with a fee waiver approved by the superintendent can receive a free Pride Pass. Fee waiver application forms are included with the registration materials.
