RE.: Reported bully incidences 2013-2014

The district is required to provide semi-annually to the president of the Board of Education a written summary of all reported incidents and to post the summary on the district Web site to the extent permitted by 3319.321 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) 1974.

On the district's Web site, there is an option for online reporting of bullying incidences. Building principals follow-up by investigating and determining recourse. The district uses Power School to log incidences.

This memo includes number of incidences reported in Power School by building principals. Districts are required by law to report incidences to the state. Data is pulled from Power School by Pam Moenter, district data base administrator/analyst, and is reported to the state's Educational Management Instruction System (EMIS). For school year 2013-2014, incidences were reported by middle and high school principals with no incidences reported by elementary principals:
