



## Bexley School District Income Tax Information

### What is the School District Income Tax (SDIT)?

This is an income tax separate from federal, state, regional and city income taxes, earmarked specifically to support the school district. The SDIT that went into effect in 2005 in Bexley is 0.75%. The tax is levied on any individual residing in the State of Ohio who lives in Bexley during all or part of a tax year.

### How do I pay the tax?

Residents pay the tax to the State of Ohio through employer withholding, individual quarterly estimates, and annual returns. The state requires employers whose employees reside in a school district that has enacted the SDIT to withhold SDIT from their employees' compensation.

### How do I notify my employer to withhold the tax?

Complete the form provided on the reverse; submit it to your employer so that your employer knows to withhold the tax. Your employer has information about districts with the SDIT, the tax rates, withholding tables and withholding formulas. The Ohio Revised Code requires that employers withhold the SDIT from paychecks (see ORC5747.06[A]).

### When do I have to file an SDIT annual return?

The School District Income Tax return is due at the same time the Ohio personal income tax return (IT-1040) is due, normally April 15. Individuals and estates subject to a SDIT must file a School District Income Tax Return, Form SD-100, with the Ohio Department of Taxation. The filing status for the SD-100 must be the same as that used for the Federal income tax returns.

### What if I do not pay the tax?

An individual not filing or paying the SDIT will be penalized under the same provisions currently in effect for Form IT-1040, Ohio Personal Income Tax Return.

### How do I pay the tax through quarterly estimates?

If you pay your taxes through quarterly estimates, complete form SD 100ES and submit to your tax preparer or mail to the State of Ohio according to the instructions provided on the form.

# What you need to know.

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### Public School District of Resident Employee Withholding Certificate

Employers are required by Ohio law (Ohio Revised Codes Section 5747.06[E]) to ask all employees for their public school district of residence. Please fill out, sign and date this form. Your exemptions are the same for school district withholding as they are for state income tax withholding purposes.
